Opening Up:

Discuss:

- 5. Matthew is arguing that Jesus is King. He sits on the thrown of your life, not you. What is different about your life when you are on the throne versus when Jesus is on the throne?
- 6. If you were to give Jesus the pen and ask him to write your next chapter. What do you think Jesus would write? How would it be different if you wrote the chapter on your own?
- 7. What is keeping you from accepting Jesus as King in your everyday life?
