## Discuss:

- 1. Verse 32 says that Jesus would be a light to the Gentiles or a light to the outsiders. Jesus did not meet the expectations of Jewish nationalism; he welcomed the outsiders to join his kingdom. How has Jesus challenged your expectations of him?
- 2. What box have you tried to place Jesus in?
- 3. What do you think it felt like to be Jesus' mom?
- 4. It was prophesied in verse 35 that a sword would pierce Mary's heart. How do you think Mary's grief over Christ being pierced on the cross was different from the grief of other witnesses to the crucifixion?
- 5. How do think the cross defied Mary's expectations of Jesus?
- 6. Jesus, through his sacrifice, became a new kind of king of a new kind of kingdom. If you were explaining King Jesus and his kingdom to a friend, how would you describe it?
- 7. Jesus did not just die; he was raised. Jesus defied the ultimate expectation of death, death's finality. How does Jesus expand your expectations?
- 8. What is something you should be praying for, but you are not?
- 9. What keeps you from expecting the unexpected through Jesus?
