2. Why is there no condemnation for those united with Christ Jesus (vv. 1-4)?
3. What is the connection between what Jesus did for us and what we do by the Spirit as men and women united with Jesus? (vv. 1-6)
4. What are we taught about the unbeliever's mind in verses 6-8? Why is it impossible for them to please God? (v. 8)
5. Who lives in all Christians, according to verses 9-11? (What are the 3 different ways the answer is described?)
6. Why does having the Spirit guarantee our future bodily resurrection? (v. 11)
7. What is our obligation as Christians? (vv. 12, 13)
8. How does someone go about putting sin to death?
9. What does the Spirit do for and in us? (vv. 14 -17)
10. How is the "spirit of adoption" distinct from the "the spirit of slavery?" (vv. 14-16)
11. In what ways do we experience the work of the Spirit as described in this chapter?
12. How can we help one another to connect this experience with our assurance of our future resurrection?
13. How can relating to God as our father be unsettling? How does this truth provide comfort?
