

Week 9 | Rise | April 30 Key Focus: Spiritual Parenting.

Opening Up:

Discuss:

- 1. On a scale of one to ten how well do you do at counseling others? What makes for a good counselor in a friend?
- 2. How would you describe what discernment is to someone?
- 3. How does someone get discernment?
- 4. Why is discipleship best described as spiritual parenting? We are told in 5:14 to "admonish idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak." In other words we are told to, confront issues of the will; comfort issues of the heart; and, instruct issues of the mind.
- 5. How can you discern the difference between issues of the will, heart, or mind?
- 6. What type of care are you better at giving: instruction, comfort, or confrontation? Why do you think that is so?
- 7. What happens when you miss-match the type of care with an issue? How have you seen each of these to be true?
 - 1. You should only confront issues of the will. You should never confront issues of the mind or heart.
 - 1. If you confront issues of the mind, you will close the mind or promote insecurities.
 - 2. If you confront issues of the heart, you will harden the heart or break the spirit.
 - 2. You should only comfort issues of the heart; you should never comfort issues of the mind or will.
 - 1. If you comfort issues of the mind, you will disable a person's development.
 - 2. If you comfort issues of the will, you will enable bad behavior.
 - 3. You only instruct issues of the mind; you should never instruct issues of the heart or will.
 - 1. If you instruct issues of the heart, you will lose their confidence.
 - 2. If you instruct issues of the will, you will lose their respect.
- 8. In what ways do you need to be a better spiritual parent to others? What do you need in your life right now: confrontation, comfort, or instruction?
- 9. In 5:16-22 we are told that suppressing the word in community will result in quenching the Spirits fire in our lives and this results in a lack of rejoicing, prayer, and thanksgiving. How have you seen this to be true?
