Reference: John 6:60-71

Discuss:

1. In John 6:60-61 Jesus offends his disciples. In 6:66 many of his disciples turned their backs on him. Has Jesus ever offended you? How have you seen Jesus offend others? How is Jesus offensive to our modern society?
2. How does your slavery to Christ affect your patriotic commitment to your freedom as an American? How does someone assure that their political views are informed by their faith and not the other way around?
3. In Galatians 5:11 Paul discusses the offense of the cross. How is the confession of sin and the receiving of grace without merit offensive? When have you chosen to try to work off your sin rather than receiving Christ's free grace?
4. Read the words of Peter as he answers Jesus from John 6:66-69. Have you ever been at the place in your life where you knew, without a doubt, that you have no one to turn to but Jesus?
5. Peter heard and believed that Jesus has the "words of eternal life." When did you first hear and believe? How has Jesus given you new life? (Romans 10:17)
6. Who in your life do you want to hear the life-giving words of Jesus?
7. Is it hard for you to share your faith? When was the last time you did it? How did it go?
8. What do you need to feel more equipped to share the gospel with someone? Does it help you to know that "salvation belongs to the Lord"? (Psalm 3:8; Luke 6:63)
