Discuss:

1. Jesus heals the blind man on the Sabbath. The Sabbath (a day of rest) was intended to teach us that we are creation and not the Creator. Is resting hard for you? How does resting make you more reliant on God?
2. There are some things that only God can do. What is something that only God can do, yet you keep trying to do it (or stress over it being done)?
3. God has made a new world and he can make anything in this world new (i.e. a blind man gain sight). What is something or someone you are praying for to be made new?
4. How have you seen Jesus make something or someone new?
5. The blind man's testimony was simply: I was blind, then Jesus, and now I see. Following this format, do you have a made new story?
6. If you were going to to explain spiritual darkness or spiritual blindness to someone, how would you explain it?
7. How has Jesus illuminated your world? He is the Light of the World.
