Opening Up:

- Were you ever afraid to take out the trash at night when you were a kid?
- Where is the creepiest place you have been at night? How was that same place different in the day time?
- Where is the coolest place you have been at night? What role did light play in making it cool?

Reference: John 8:1-20

Discuss:

1. Jesus is the “Light of the World” and his followers do not “walk in darkness.” How has the light of Jesus changed the way you walk (or live) in the recent past?
2. Jesus does not judge “according to the flesh.” You might say that the judgements of Jesus are spiritually informed. How has walking by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7) informed your thinking, past or present?
3. Can you explain how the calculus in decision making is different when your mind is informed spiritually as well as naturally?
4. One piece of spiritual insight is the knowledge that Jesus is making all things new (Revelation 21:5). The New City of God is where Jesus is headed (Revelations 21:2). What is your “made new” story? How has Jesus been doing his renewal work in your life? What do you hope Jesus will make new in your life?
5. Jesus gives us the opportunity to be a “light to the world” (Matthew 5:14). Who are you praying for to be made new?
